Fall Update

Greetings,

A new season is upon us and that means new opportunities to serve the King. Let me share some highlights from this summer and some opportunities I have coming up this fall.

During this past summer I have been teaching theology courses at Grace School of Theology both in the Masters level (Hermeneutics) and Doctoral level (Contemporary Theological Issues). This continues to be a joy for me and I sense that it prepared men for ministry. I also have been editing three books for Grace Theology Press that will be published by the end of October.

With the new fall semester I will be teaching courses on Hermeneutics, Bibliology & Theology Proper, as well as a doctoral seminar on “Issues in Contemporary Apologetics.”

I also have begun a discipleship program for pastors. Our school takes seriously the need to disciple men for ministry and so I have a group in which I have been investing some of my time. This is what Paul instructed Timothy as a pattern for a ministry of multiplication (2 Tim. 2:2).

I have a few exciting speaking opportunities this fall:

- I will speak at the Free Grace Alliance national conference in Dallas in October.
- I will be traveling to the Houston area to speak at the Baytown Community Church Bible Conference in October. I will be teaching four sessions on the book of I John.
- I have been asked to speak at the Grace conference in Manila, Philippines for pastors on “Issues in Grace Theology.” This will be the third time I have done this daylong seminar to different groups of pastors. We usually have about 50 people at the seminar and last time we had an additional 1400 watching on the Face Book live streaming of the event. The good news is that I will be in my office in Dallas broadcasting Friday night from 8 p.m. until 3 a.m. Saturday morning. This allows the pastors to go to the seminar on Saturday (Manila is 13 hours ahead of Texas time.) I must admit it is a long night for me, but no jet lag is a good thing!
- I will be teaching an Introduction to Ministry class in Birmingham, Alabama.

I continue to teach our Sunday morning Bible class, Joint Heirs, at Grace Bible Church in Dallas. I also teach a small group Bible study twice a month. We will be studying the Book of Revelation chapters 2-3. I also have had the privilege of being asked to teach a weekly Friday morning Bible study that was started 50 years ago! It is the oldest continuing Bible study in the Dallas metroplex. I remember one of my professors from seminary who taught this group 39 years ago telling me how much he enjoyed it. I feel very honored to have the opportunity to carry on in presenting the Word of God to this group.

I wish to thank all of you who financially support Grace Line because you allow me to continue to invest my life in these very important and strategic ministries. As always, I appreciate it very much and hope you will continue.
