As I am sure you know, the designation of Metaxoi is a special partner, one who helps King Jesus rule His kingdom. (**For we have become Metaxoi of Christ if we hold fast our confidence firm until the end. Heb.3:14.**)

As a leader in the Church of Jesus Christ you have a strategic role that many do not have, which is to educate, encourage, and exhort fellow believers in their walk with Christ. As a result you have a larger responsibility. My goal is to provide you with a resource that will help you stay on top of certain theological issues that impact your ministry.

We serve as trainers: coming onto the field when people are injured by conflict and need the power of the gospel to heal their hearts, forgive great wrongs, and inspire them to stay with their marriage or their church.

We also act as referees: stepping in when believers clash, reminding them of God's boundary lines, mediating disputes, and making it possible for estranged people to reconcile and continue working together to display the love of Christ and advance His kingdom.”

We consider it a high calling and honor to guard the blind side of God's people. Few things in life are as rewarding as preventing a divorce, rebuilding unity in a shattered congregation or getting a missionary back out in the field. Each of these roles we play is described and prescribed by God's word. It is essential that we maintain our time in the word of God so we can do the work for God. So, let me encourage you, and exhort if necessary, as you prepare for 2010 -- fight the “Tyranny of the Urgent” and make sure that you “Sharpen the Saw” so you can serve effectively and efficiently for the Lord. Remember - “Live with the End in Mind.”

Today's Theological Conundrum

(www.ManhattanDeclaration.org) In a nut shell, it is "Evangelical and Catholics Together" Round Two. It is a movement of Chuck Colson, some Evangelicals, Roman Catholic Church, and Eastern Orthodox leaders in an attempt to galvanize "Christians" to create a block-vote power base. I agree with the ends they seek--- No abortion, no active euthanasia or gay marriage etc... but I am concerned about their means of accomplishing their goal. Please read the TMD document. *Let me pass on to you a new resource that is vital for answering many questions that come from those who adhere to radical Calvinism or to some of the teaching of John Piper. The book is a dissertation that I supervised at Phoenix Seminary and later published. It is called *Back to Faith: Reclaiming the Gospel Clarity in an Age of Incongruence* by Dr. Fred Lybrand. It is an attempt to respond to the cliché, 'We are saved by faith alone, but the faith is not alone.' This book evaluates the cliché and both the logic and theology behind it. I think you will find it to be very pastor friendly and people helpful. I know that many of you have people who listen to and who are blessed by many things Dr. John Piper says. However, we also know that many people are confused or corrupted by some of the things he says. I think you will find this book a real help for your ministry. * I hope you are aware of the issue regarding the Cross-less Gospel that is being articulated by many who are in the grace theology movement, especially the leadership of the Grace Evangelical Society. I feel that this is a dangerous error and one that needs to be addressed. I have written on this many times, but a new book has come out that is the best source to understand and refute this error. *The Gospel of the Christ: A Biblical Response to the Crossless Gospel Regarding the Contents of Saving Faith* by Tom Stegall. This is a book you need to read. It is long and costly, but I exhort you to read it for the sake of the church and the Lord Jesus. You must be up on this issue.

*Finally, let me tell you of another resource. It is a booklet that I wrote called *The Glorious Grace of God: Understanding Free Grace theology*. It is a 35 page booklet that is written for laypeople (Only two footnotes and no Greek!) It is a simple way to get the basics out on the table in a non-offensive way to further discussion.
